



Paper Piecing – New York Beauty – Nina Hancock

Book: Paper Piecing with Alex Anderson

Rotary cutter
6" x 24" ruler & medium size mat
Scissors for paper & for fabric
Thread, either neutral or gray
Pins
small iron & pad
Add-A-Quarter Ruler
seam ripper
Sewing machine & needles, 80/12 or 90/14.

I will provide the paper; we will be trying different kinds of paper.

Fabric: Using fabric that does not have a right or wrong side (such as batik) makes it easier to learn this method. Check the book; since we are making only 2 blocks (2 parts of one New York Beauty), fat quarters of each color should work.

For the tote bag:
Fabric for the bag & handles 3/4 yard
Fabric for the lining & inside pockets 3/4 yard
Fusible Pellon 3/4 yard
Optional: webbing for handles 1 1/3 yards

If you have reserved one of our shop machines to use in class, please also bring the following:

- Machine needle appropriate for your class. Please take your needle home with you at the end of class.
- Thread - Please use only good quality thread in our machines. We prefer Mettler or Aurifil for piecing. No WalMart thread, no cotton-covered polyester, please.
- We will provide you with one bobbin for use in class. If you prefer to buy your own, we also sell the bobbins here.

- Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before the start of class to allow the teacher and shop staff time to prepare the classroom. If your class requires a sewing machine, try to arrive a few minutes early to get your sewing machine set up.

- In consideration of other students and employees with allergies, please limit your use of scented personal products when attending one of our classes.

- If your class requires a sewing machine, please be sure that you are familiar with its operation, it is in good working order, and bring your manual along to class just in case!

- Cancellation policy: If the class minimum is not met within seven days prior to the class, it may be cancelled and you will be notified and will receive a full refund. Please keep this possibility in mind when you purchase supplies for your class. No refunds of class fees will be given if student cancels within the one week prior to class.
